



## ARIA DESK LAMP

# Instructions

Please read these instructions and warnings carefully before operating to ensure safe and satisfactory operation of this product.

Please also retain these instructions for future use.

### Warnings:

- This is a Class II product and does not require an earth connection.
- Always use the correct type and wattage of bulb.
- When changing a bulb, always switch off the light at the wall socket and allow the bulb to cool down before handling.
- Ensure bulb is fully inserted, but take care not to over tighten. When the bulb is fully threaded, do not apply additional force as this can cause damage to the bulb and lamp holder.
- Dispose of old bulbs carefully.
- Only use the lamp fitting on a stable / dry and level support surface.
- Do not place in a position where it can be easily knocked over or where a hazard could exist from it falling from height. Position out of reach from small children.
- Do not switch on the light until the assembly is complete.
- Do not cover the lamp or bulb during use as this could be a potential safety hazard
- Turn off the lamp fitting when not in use.
- The product is not intended for use by children unless suitable adult supervision is provided.
- Children should be supervised to ensure they do not play with the lamp fitting.
- The lamp fitting is intended for indoor use only.
- If the external flexible cable or cord of this lamp fitting is damaged, it shall be exclusively replaced by the manufacturer or his service agent or a similar qualified person in order to avoid a hazard.
- To prevent damage to the mains cord, do not let it pass over sharp corners, edges or hot surfaces.
- This lamp fitting should only be used on a flat and stable surface.
- This lamp fitting is not intended for use by persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance, by a person responsible for their safety.
- Never touch the bare bulb with your bare fingers or hands.
- Grease or oil from fingers can damage the bulb and cause the bulb to burn out, or reduce its operating life, it is recommended to use soft cloth or facial tissue when handling the bulb.

**CAUTION:** Ensure that the light bulb is not within the recommended 0.5m of any surface when operating as this could be a potential safety hazard.

**CAUTION:** Never exceed the bulb wattage stated.

## Assembly and operation:

1. Remove any protective packaging materials from the light fitting.
2. Install the recommended bulb.  
NOTE: The rated bulb is E27, 40W Max, but the recommended bulb wattage is 5.5W to 9W of the LED bulb type. Bulb used will vary depending on personal preference.  
**CAUTION:** Never over tighten bulbs as this could result in permanent damage and potential short circuit to the lamp holder. Ensure bulb is fully inserted, but when fully threaded, do not apply additional force as this can cause damage to the bulb and lamp holder, resulting in potential short circuit of the mains supply.
3. Place the lamp fitting on a stable / dry and level support surface.
4. Insert the supply cord plug into a suitable mains outlet and use the in-line cord switch to operate.
