- 5) Do not use this apparatus near water.
- Clean only with dry cloth.
- 7) Do not block any ventilation openings. Ventilation should not be impeded by covering the ventilation openings with items such as newspapers, table-cloths, curtains etc. There must be a minimum distance of 5cm clear space around the unit at all times to ensure proper ventilation.
- 8) Do not install near any heat sources such as radiators, heat registers, stoves, or other apparatus (including amplifiers) that produce heat. No naked flame sources, such as lit candles, should be placed on or near the unit.
- 9) Protect the power cord from being walked on or pinched particularly at plugs, convenience receptacles, and the point where they exit from the apparatus.



TV Jacks Explanation



HDMI1, 2, 3: (**High-Definition** Multimedia Interface) It provides an uncompressed digital connection that carries both video and audio data by way of an integrated mini-plug cable.

YPbPr: Connect a device that has component video jacks, such as a DVD player.

PC Audio in: Use to obtain sound when a PC is connected to TV. Use 3.5mm stereo mini-pin cable to connect PC to TV.

VGA: Connect your computer or other device with a VGA output to this jack using a 15-pin, D-sub cable.

RF: Connect to receive the signal from your antenna or cable via coaxial cable .

COAX: Digital TV sound output.

USB: Connect USB device, such as flash disk to access media function of TV.

CVBS,R/L: Connect an AV device that has composite video jacks, such as a VCR or DVD player.


AUDIO-IN R: Right audio channel connection. the right audio connector is usually red.

AUDIO-IN L: Left audio channel connection. The left audio connector is usually white.

Side Keypad and Front Panel

Side Keypad Buttons

If you cannot locate your remote, you can use the side keypad buttons on your TV to operate many TV features.



INPUT: Displays the Source Select List.

MENU: Displays the TV Main Menu.

CHA: Scans up through the channel list. In the TV menu system, it acts like the up arrow on the remote control and can be used to select menu options.

CH▼: Scans down through the channel list. In the TV menu system, it acts like the down arrow on the remote control and can be used to select menu options.

VOL+: Increases the volume. In the TV menu system, it acts like the right arrow on the remote control and can be used to select menu options.


VOL-:Decreases the volume. In the TV menu system, it acts like the left arrow on the remote control and can be used to select menu options.

POWER (&): Turns the TV on and off.


Power/Standby Indicator: Blue and red dual-color LED. It shows red when the TV is turned off and blue when turned on. Remote Control Sensor: Remote control IR sensor, which receives infrared ray sent by remote control.




Remote Control Instructions

Inserting Batteries in the Remote

- Remove the cover of battery cabin on the back of the remote control by lifting the cover.
- Insert two AAA batteries, making sure the polarities (+ and -) are aligned correctly.
- Place the cover back.







If the remote control does not work, check these points:

- Are the polarities (+, -) correct?
- Are the batteries worn out?
- Is there an AC power failure?
- Is the power cord plugged in?
- Is there any interference or block near the remote control sensor?




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Remote Control Buttons

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MUTE (♥): Reduces the TV volume to its minimum level. Press again to restore the volume.

NUMBER BUTTONS: Press 0-9 select a TV channel directly when you are watching TV.

"-/--": Press once for entering two-digit channels. Press two times for entering three-digit channels.

Recall (5): Returns to the previous channel.

AUDIO: Switch the audio channel in DVD or multimedia mode.

FAV-./FAV+.: Scan up or down through the current favorite channel list.

FAV: Adds the current channel to your favorite list, or erases the current channel from your favorite list (if this channel is a favorite channel already).

CH+ or CH-: Scans up or down through the current channel list. Press once to change the channel up or down; press and hold to continue changing channels.

 $\ensuremath{\mathsf{VOL+}}$ or $\ensuremath{\mathsf{VOL-}}\xspace$: Increases or decreases the TV volume.

SMODE: Switches between the preset sound mode.

INPUT:Accesses the available input channels, Use the arrows to highlight options, and press OK to select.

SLEEP: Selects the sleep timer, after which the TV will shut off automatically.

ASPECT: Switches between the preset screen size mode.

INFO: Press to display the current program information on the screen.

Arrows (◀ / ▶ /▲ / ▼): Uses the four arrows to highlight different items in the TV menu or change the value.

OK: Enter and confirm button.

MENU: Accesses the Main Menu, or return to the upper level of a sub-menu.

EXIT: Exits the current menu or function.

TEXT: To enter Teletext mode. Teletext is not broadcast in New Zealand.

INDEX: To display the index page.

MIX: TV and TXT picture are mixed together in transparent background.

REVEAL: Teletext mode-To reveal or hide the hidden words.

HOLD: Teletext mode-Hode current page which is display.

SUBPAGE: Sub coded page access.

SUB-T: Display caption information

CANCEL: To cancel the display.

T-SHIFT: Press to activate Time Shift function in Digital TV mode, for delayed viewing.

A USB memory device must be connected to the USB port for this function.

TV/RADIO: Switch between TV and RADIO.(Used for models with DTV function only))
REC: Presonal video record button. A USB memory device must be connected to the USB port for recording.

EPG: Shows Electronic Program Guide.

■ : PAUSE and STOP.

Fast review and fast forward.

(Select the previous or the next media file.

RED/GREEN/YELLOW/BLUE: Use add-on functions in OSD menu.

Basic Operations

Turning On and Off

Connect the AC cord to power the TV. At this time the TV will enter standby mode and power indicator will turn red. Use Power button (ω) on the side panel of TV or on the remote control to turn on the TV. After switching off the TV for 5 seconds, you can turn on TV again.

Select input source

Press INPUT button on remote control to display Source Select list.

Use ▲ / ▼ arrows to highlight the source you need and press ENTER to confirm.



Adjust the OSD Screen

The OSD (On Screen Display) menu enables you to approach to the TV functions.

To use OSD menu system, press MENU button on remote control, then use ◀ / ▶ arrow to highlight an option from CHANNEL, PICTURE, SOUND, TIME, Lock or Setup and press ENTER/▼ button.

Press the ▲ /▼ arrow to move to a different option within each menu. If necessary, press ENTER or ▶ arrow to display the choices of the option you've highlighted. If available, use the text at the bottom of each screen for help. To return to the previous menu, press the MENU button.


To exit the OSD menu:

- Press the EXIT button. The menu will clear from the screen.
- Press the MENU button repeatedly until the menus disappear.

CHANNEL menu

CHANNEL menu is used for channel searching and edit, it's only available in TV input.

Press MENU on the remote. Select CHANNEL from the Main menu. Press the ENTER button to proceed to CHANNEL menu.






Channel tuning: search channel automatically.
 You can stop searching with MENU button.




ATV Manual tuning: search the channel manually.
 You can customise the color/sound system, frequency of channel.

 Use the arrows button to select DTV Manual Tuning, then press Enter button to enter sub-menu,



 Programme Edit: via color buttons you can edit the programme, functions include delete, skip channel, etc.

- Schedule List Show the Schedule list, it is available under DTV source.
- Software Update(OAD)
 In the case of passed OAD certification, software could be upgraded on line.

EPG stands for Digital Electronic Program Guide. It is supplied by the program providers and offers information about the programs to be broadcast. You can access it in digital mode by pressing the EPG button on the remote control.

1. Press the EPG button to bring up the EPG interface (below).

The second bar from the top will display the current date and time. On the list below, the channel you are currently watching will be highlighted.



2.Before you can view any EPG information, you have to 'activate' every channel for which you want to view program information. To do this, use the ▲/▼ buttons to select a channel, then press 「ENTER] to confirm.

3.To check programs to be broadcast on a different date, use the Yellow/Blue button to select the date, the program on the previous/next day will be displayed.

4.Go to the channel and use the ▲/▼ buttons to select the channel for which you want to view information. After a brief moment, the program information will appear on the second bar.

5.Use the ▶ buttons to enter the time list, and use the ▲/▼ buttons to scroll through the time slots.

6.To exit out of the EPG menu, press the EXIT button.

Press the RED button to switch to PVR mode. Here, you can set the time to record your chosen program.

Press the GREEN button to set a reminder for a particular program.


Press the YELLOW button to set the previous day's information.

Press the BLUE button to set the next day's information.

PICTURE menu

PICTURE menu is used for TV picture effect adjusting.

Press MENU on the remote. Select PICTURE from the Main menu. Press the ENTER button to proceed to PICTURE menu.



- Picture mode: select the preset picture mode. You can also switch the mode via PMODE button on remote control.
 You can only customise the contrast, color, brightness and tint in User mode.
- · Contrast: Adjust the contrast of TV display.
- · Brightness: Adjust the brightness of TV display.
- · Color: Adjust the color saturation of TV display.
- · Tint: Adjust the tint of TV display. Only available in NTSC channel.
- · Sharpness: Adjusts the sharpness of TV display.
- Color Temperature: Adjust the color temperature of TV display. Set the TV picture display from colder to warmer.
- Noise Reduction: Adjust the noise reduction level of TV display.

SOUND menu

SOUND menu is used for TV sound effect adjusting.

Press MENU on the remote. Select SOUND from the Main menu. Press the ENTER button to proceed to SOUND menu.



- Sound mode: select the preset Sound mode. You can also switch the mode via SMODE button on remote control.
 You can only customise the treble and bass in User mode.
- · Treble: Adjust the treble level of TV sound.
- · Bass: Adjust the bass level of TV sound.
- Balance: Adjust the balance between left and right channels.
- Auto Volume: Select auto volume control on/off, This limits the volume fluctuation between different channels.
- SPDIF: Select three modes area available including Auto, PCM and Off.
- AD Switch: Enter the AD Switch sub-menu, then select this option to adjust AD volume.

TIME menu

TIME menu is used for TV TIME adjusting.

Press MENU on the remote. Select TIME from the Main menu. Press the ENTER button to proceed to TIME menu.



- Clock: Set the TV clock.
- · Time Zone: Showing the country's time zone.
- · Sleep Timer: Set the sleep timer counting down.
- Auto Standby: When you turn this on, the TV will sleep automatically after a period of no-operation time.
- OSD Timer: Set the OSD displaying time.

LOCK MENU

Lock menu is used for TV Lock effect adjusting.

Press MENU on the remote. Select LOCK from the Main menu. Press the ENTER button to proceed to LOCK menu.



- Lock System press ENTER button to enter, input password, default password is 0000.
- Set Password: To set your own password, first enter the old password, and then enter your new password twice.
- Block Program: To enter "Block Program" menu, select the program you want to "Lock", and press the "Green" button.
- Parental Guidance: You can set the parental control function to suit viewing for children of all ages. Choose the categories
 in the sub menu.
- · Clock: Set the TV clock.
- Key Lock: You can set to lock or unlock the keypad.

OPTION menu

OPTION menu is used for TV additional options.

Press MENU on the remote. Select OPTION from the Main menu. Press the ENTER button to proceed to OPTION menu.



- · OSD Language: Select your desired OSD language.
- · Hearing impaired: This function is for the Hearing Impaired, when the status is on, you can see subtitles in the programs.
- · PVR File System: To Check and format your USB Disk to be compatible with the PVR file system of this model.
- Aspect Ratio: To select between the available modes: Auto, 4:3, 16:9, Zoom1, Zoom2 and Full Screen.
- Blue Screen: To turn the blue screen on/off. If the Blue Screen is turned on, the TV will display a blue background when there is no signal input.
- First Time Installation: To set relevant options, including OSD language, country and tuning.
- Reset: Press ENTER button to enter a dialogue, select Yes to restore factory default.
- · Software Update (USB): Update the firmware of this model. (Please contact Customer Service to see if an update is available)
- HDMI CEC: Press ENTER button to enter sub-menu. Consumer Electronics Control (CEC) allows you to control multiple CEC-enabled devices connected using HDMI, with a single remote control.


HDMI CEC Turn on or off the HDMI CEC function.

Auto Power Turn on or off the auto power.

Device Menu Open the main menu of device.

PVR File System

To Check and format your USB Disk to be compatible with the PVR file system of this model. Select "Check PVR File System" to check your USB Disk. Select "Format" to format your USB Disk to be compatible with this model. Select "Free Record Limit" to set the record limit for your USB Disk.





IMPORTANT NOTE:

For any type of recording with this television, you must have plugged a USB device into the appropriate USB port at the back of the television to record on.

- 1.Please insert the external high-speed storage devices, insert must be formatted before.
- 2. Select the DTV program and channel you wish to record.
- 3.Press [REC] button to enter PVR mode and start recording. PVR control bar on the screen shown above. You can select the appropriate settings required. You could change the mode of Recording menu by ENTER button.
- 4.If you wish to stop the recording, press [] button and the recording will stop.

Insert the USB device to the USB port of TV back panel, then select Media in input source menu, press ENTER.



Troubleshooting

Before consulting service personnel, check the following chart for a possible cause of the trouble you are experiencing and for a solution.

PROBLEM	SOLUTION
TV will not turn on	 Make sure that the main power switch at the bottom right of the TV has been turned on. Make sure the power cord is plugged in. The batteries in the remote control may be dead. Replace the batteries if necessary.
l don't receive all the available channels or am having reception problems	Your antenna may not be sensitive enough or positioned properly, especially if you are using an indoor antenna. We recommend connection to a professionally installed external antenna. Some indoor antennas may work depending on your location to the broadcasting tower, however they usually won't tune all available channels and can produce intermittent reception.
My Sky box (or other device) is causing problems with the TV	Try turning your TV on before turning your Sky box on.
No picture, no sound	 Check the interface cable between TV and antenna/cable TV. Press the power button on the remote. Press the INPUT button on the remote, then press the INPUT button repeatedly to select the TV sources.
Poor picture, sound OK	Check the interface cable between TV and antenna/cable TV. Try another channel. The station may have broadcast difficulties. Adjust the brightness/contrast options in the Video menu.
Picture OK, Poor sound	Sound may be muted. Press the MUTE button on the remote, Press the TV button on the remote, then press the VOL+ button to increase the volume.
Audio noise	Move any infrared equipment away from the TV.
l've lost or damaged my remote control	Please call customer service to buy a new one. Please note that universal remote controls will not work with this television.
When I connect my computer, the outer edges get cropped out	 Using the TV's menu, select "Aspect Ratio" and change the value to either "Underscan" or "Point to Point". Once complete, set your computer's video output to 1920x1080 for best performance.

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
