OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS (CONT.)

• If more Popcorn is required, remove any Popcorn remaining in the Aluminum Heat Chamber. Take care when handling the Top Cover or Measuring Cup as these parts get very hot when the Popcorn Maker is functioning.

NOTE: 1 measuring cup of comels makers approximately 4 cups of popcorn.

After use, wait for approx.10 to 15 miuntes before using the Popcorn Maker again.

WARNING

- Popcorn and kernels may become hot during use.
- Never put the butter into the Aluminum Heat Chamber.

CLEANING AND CARE

- Before cleaning, remove the supply plug from the mains electrical supply.
- Make sure the Popcorn Maker has cooled down completely before cleaning.
- Clean the plastic parts of the Popcorn maker with a damp cloth. Never use abrasive products as they could damage the Popcorn maker.
- The Top Cover and the Measuring Cup can be cleaned in warm soapy water.
- Never immerse the body of the appliance in liquid!

STORAGE

When the Popcorn Maker is not in use, disconnect from the electrical supply and store in a safe, dry place, out of reach of children.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- Place the Popcorn Maker on a level surface
- Before first use, it is recommended to wipe the external surfaces of the Popcorn Maker and the accessories with a damp cloth.
- Ensure the main on/off switch is in the off position, then connect the supply plug to the mains supply socket.
- Measure corn kernels using the Measuring Cup provided. One full measure per session is enough. More than one full measure could overfill the Popcorn Maker and affect the correct functioning of the Popcorn Maker.
- Preheating of the appliance is not necessary.
- Do not add any other ingredients such as: oil, shortening, butter, margarine, salt or sugar, as damage will occur.
- Pour the corn kernels into the Aluminum Heat Chamber
- Place the top cover back on the main body.
- Replace the Measuring Cup into position inside the Top Cover after every use.
- If buttered popcorn is desired, place 2-3 tablespoons of room temperature butter, cut into 4 equally sized parts, into the measuring cup.
- Note: Do not use refrigerated butter as it will not melt completely during the short popping cycle.
- DO NOT remove the measuring/ butter cup during the popping cycle. If unbuttered popcorn is desired, it is still necessary to place the measuring cup into the cover. Never run the popcorn popper without the cover and measuring cup in place
- Place a large bowl under the Spout so that the edge of the bowl is touching the body of the Popcorn Maker. It is important that the Popcorn ejects down the Spout into the bowl and not redirected, blocked or interfered with.
- Switch on the Popcorn Maker. After a few moments the continuous popping action will automatically feed Popcorn from the Aluminum Heat Chamber out through the Spout until all the kernels has popped. This process will last about 2-3 minutes
- Switch off the Popcorn Maker and remove the mains plug from the mains supply when popping has stopped.
- If butter was melted in the measuring cup, pour over the top of the popped corn and sprinkle with salt or other popcorn seasonings as desired.

IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed, including the following:

Read all Instructions.

- The temperature of accessible surfaces may be high when the appliance is operating. To protect against fire, electric shock and injury, do not immerse cord, plug or the popcorn maker in water or other liquids.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- 3. Unplug the cord from the outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning the appliance.
- 4. DO NOT operate the Popcorn Maker with a damaged cord or plug.
- If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer or its service agent or a similarly qualified person in order to avoid a hazard.
- 6. To reduce the risk or injury, use only accessory attachments as recommended by the appliance manufacturer.
- 7. Do not use the popcorn maker outdoors
- 8. Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- 9. Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- 10. Extreme caution must be used when moving an appliance containing hot oil or other hot liquids.
- 11. For use only on 220-240VAC 50Hz rated voltage. Use an outlet with a good ground connection.
- 12. Do not use appliance for other than intended use.
- 13. Do not leave the popcorn maker unattended while in use.14. Always turn the power off at the power outlet before you insert or


