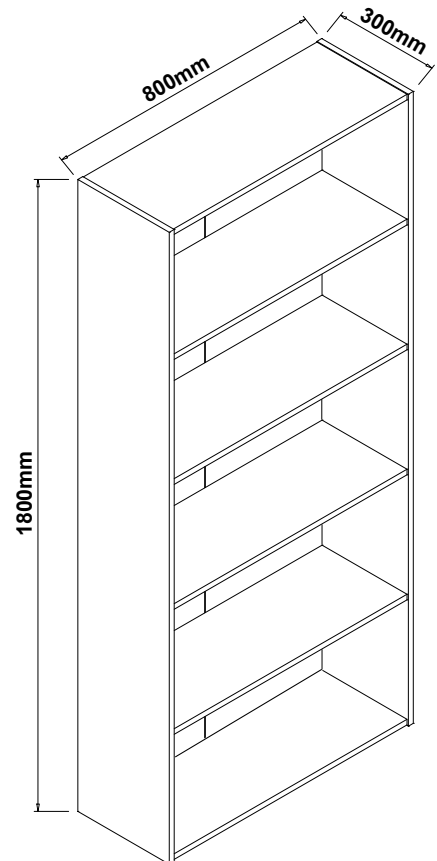

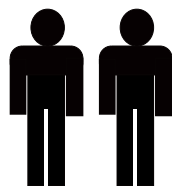

Tips Before You Start

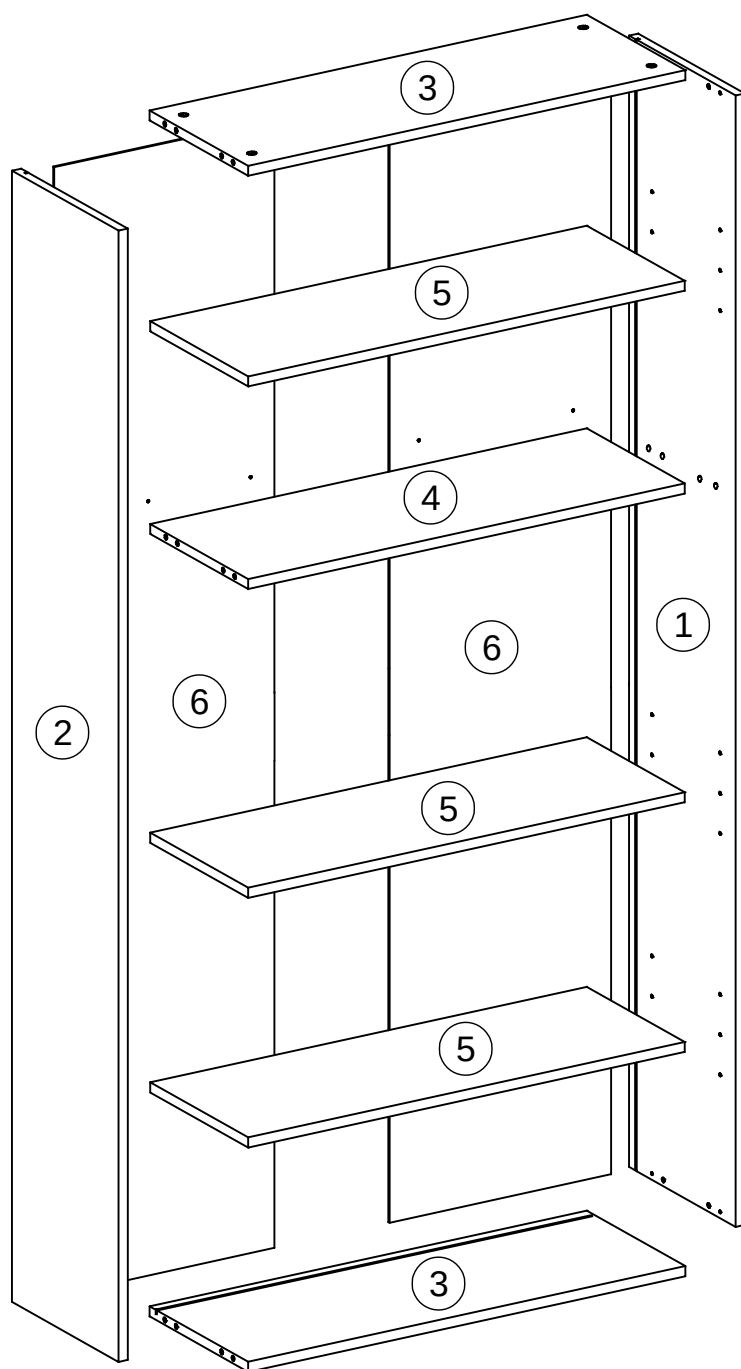
- 1 For the protection of your furniture, we recommend that the product is placed on a protected surface during assembly to prevent any damage.
- 2 Please check that all parts are present before you start the assembly of your furniture.
- 3 For ease and speed of assembly, we recommend that you identify all the parts required for each step before commencing assembly.
- 4 For larger items, please ensure that you have sufficient space and people (as indicated on page 1) to assemble your product safely.
- 5 We recommend that, where possible, all items are assembled near to the area in which they will be placed in use, to avoid moving the product unnecessarily.
- 6 During assembly please take care not to over-tighten hardware, as this may damage the product. Do not use power tools.
- 7 Always place the product on a steady and stable surface.
- 8 Do not stand on the product. Do not use the product as a stepladder.
- 9 This product is intended for indoor, household use only as it is a non-industrial product.
- 10 Please use caution and care when lifting the product to avoid personal injury and/or product damage.

Care and Maintenance

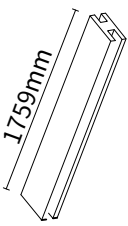
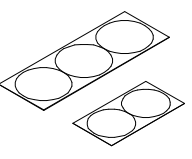
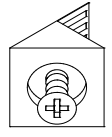
- ✓ Please periodically check all things and re-tighten as necessary.
- ✓ To clean your item, please use a damp cloth and wipe clean.

- ✓ Please do not place hot items (eg: hot drinks) directly onto the surface.

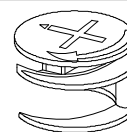

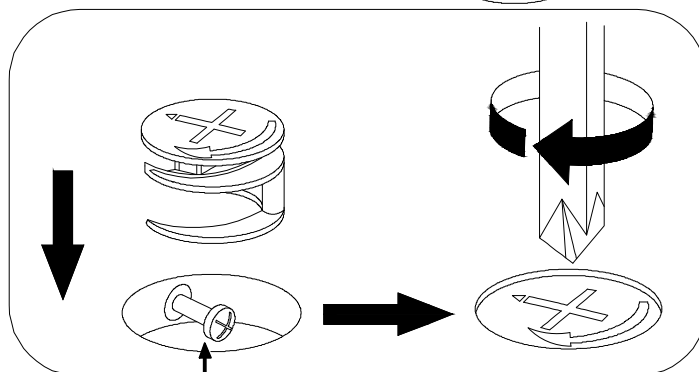
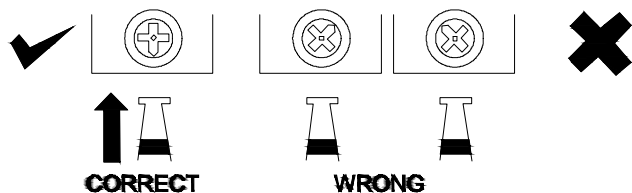

CAM-LOCK



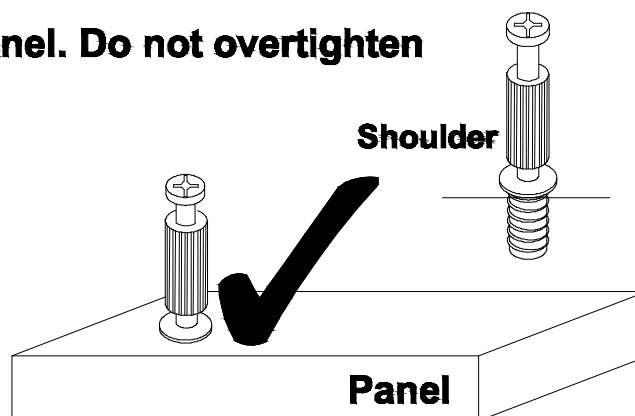
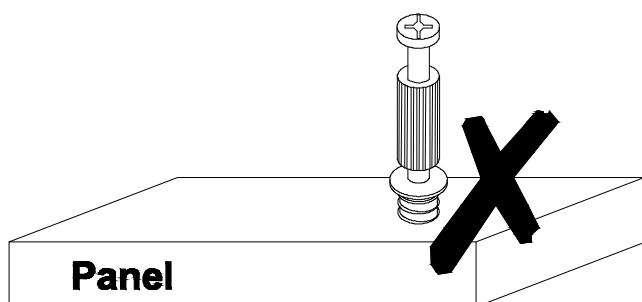
WHEN FITTING CAMLOCK
ENSURE STARTING POSITION IS CORRECT
BEFORE YOU INSERT CONNECTING QUICKFIT
TURN CLOCKWISE UNTIL SECURE



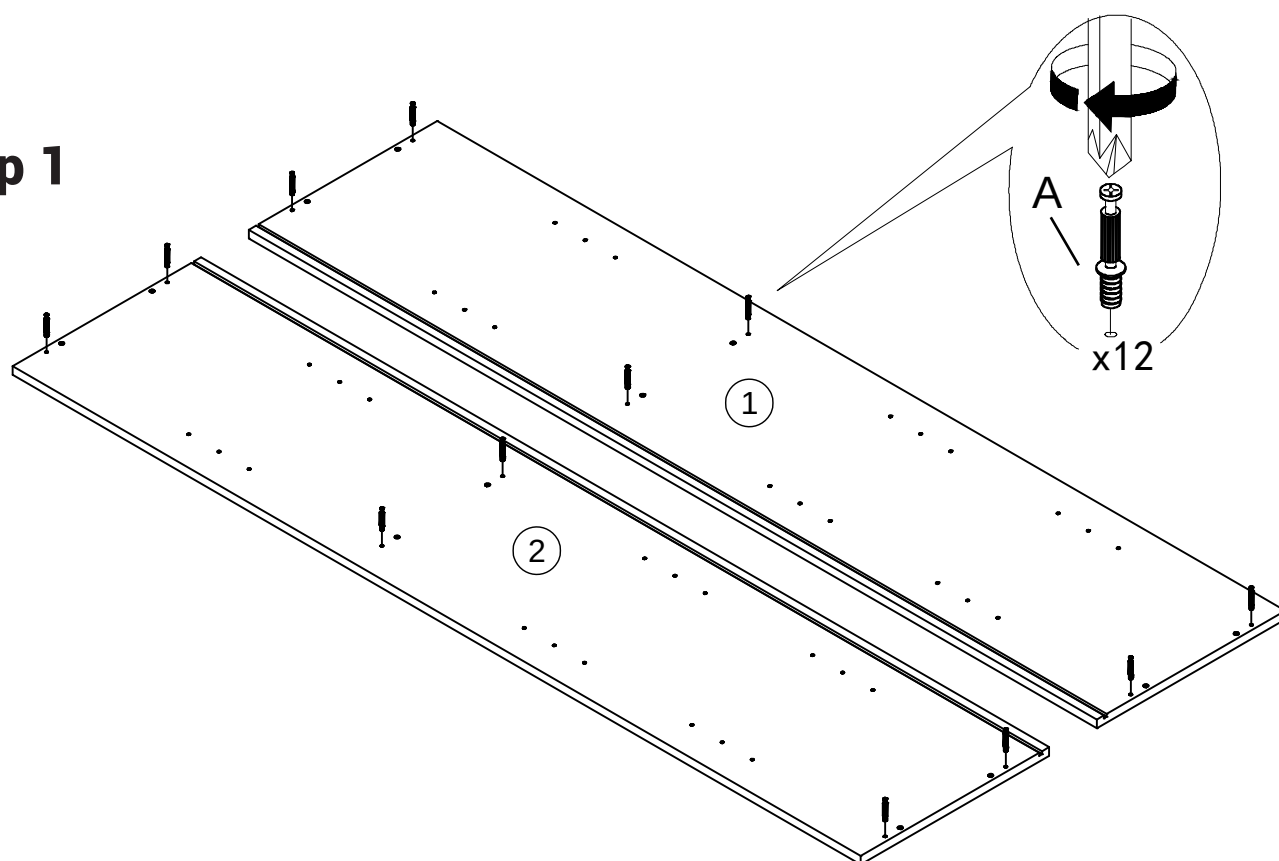
Quickfit head needs to be in centre

QUICKFIT

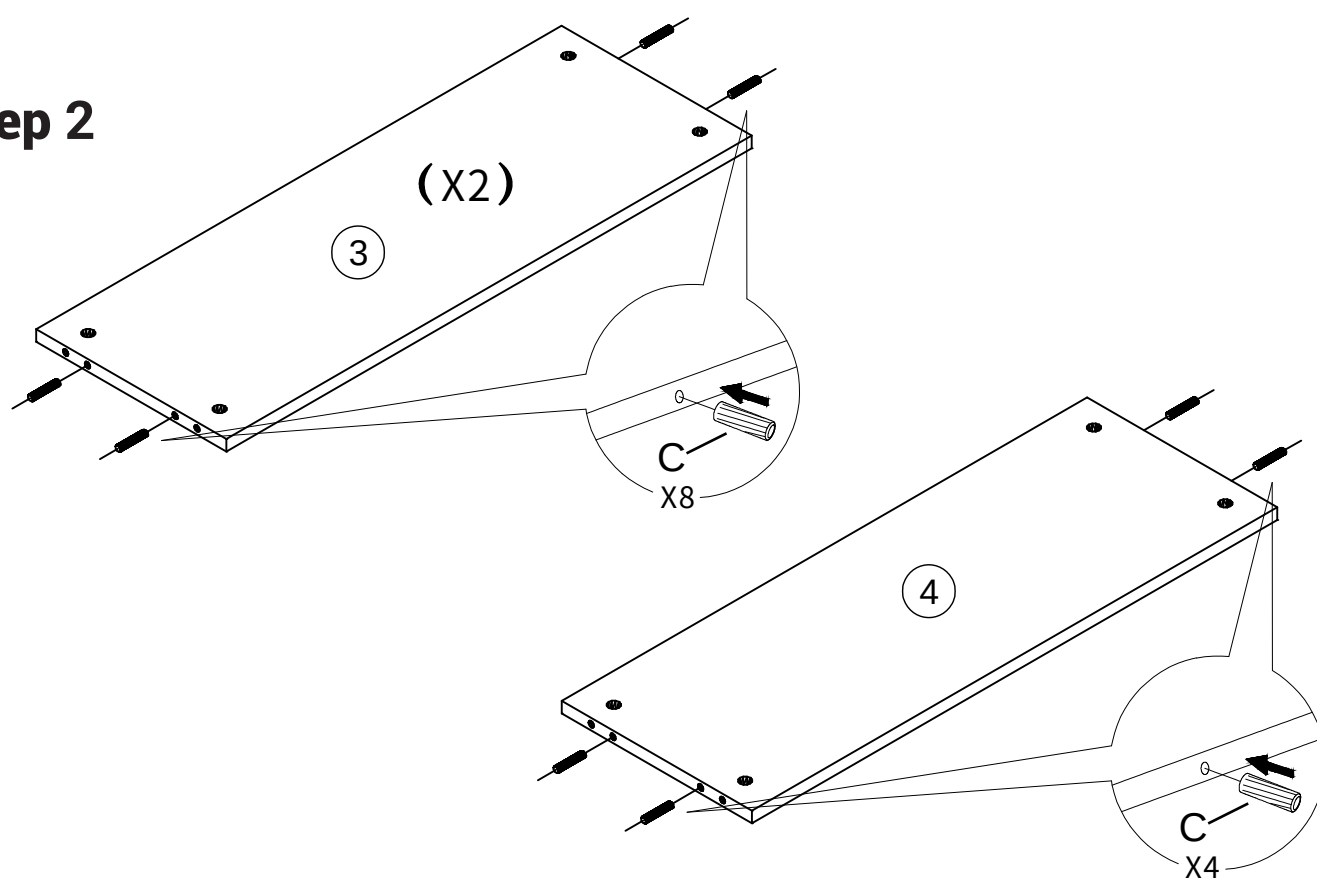
Tighten until shoulder is flush with panel. Do not overtighten or undertighten (see example below)



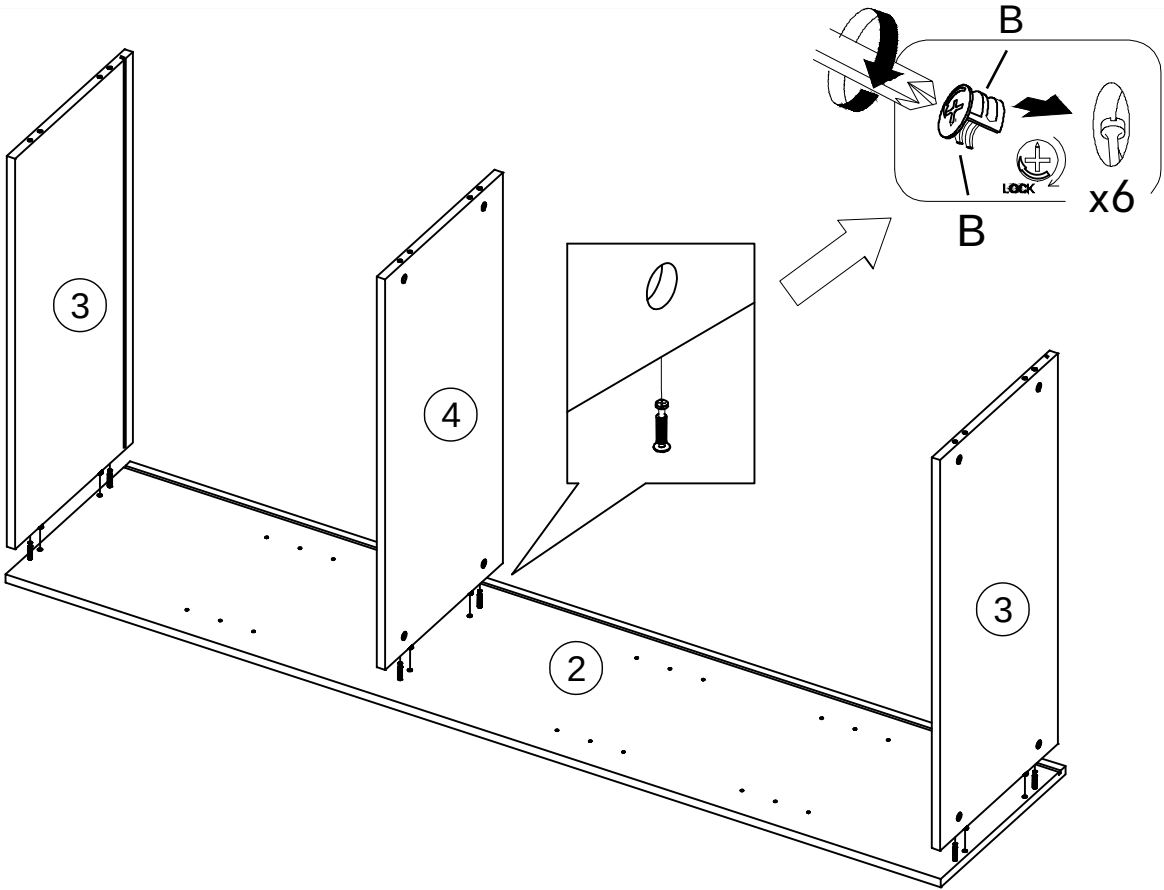

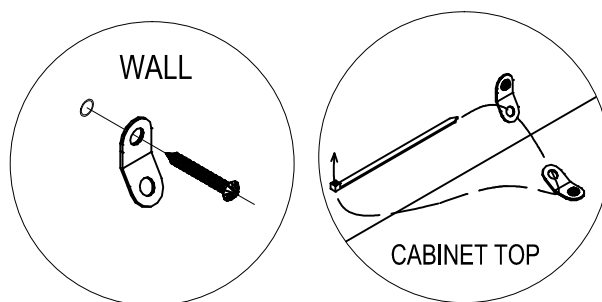




STEP1:
Insert screws through angle bracket (smaller hole) onto cabinet.

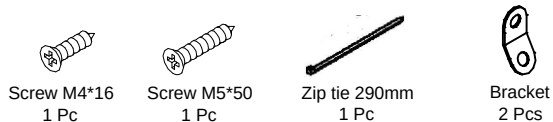


STEP2:
Drill a hole in the wall and insert the rawlplug



STEP1:
Insert screws(M5x50mm) through bracket (smaller hole) into hole in wall. Lace the flatten end of the zip tie through both the larger holes on each bracket. Feed the flatten end into the locking end of the zip tie, draw and tighten, leave no slack.
