

SPACE RANGER WINGS

These wings might not give you the power to fly, but you'll definitely be able to fall with style!

YOU'LL NEED

- Large cardboard box
- Construction paper (purple, green, red, white and blue)
- Craft glue
- Elastic or ribbon
- Scissors
- Cardboard tubes
- Two small balls
- Paint (red and green) and a brush
- Two people! One Space Ranger and a helper

*TIP! If you don't have any construction paper, you can paint the wings instead.

STEP BY STEP

1

Draw the wing shape as below onto a large cardboard box and cut out.



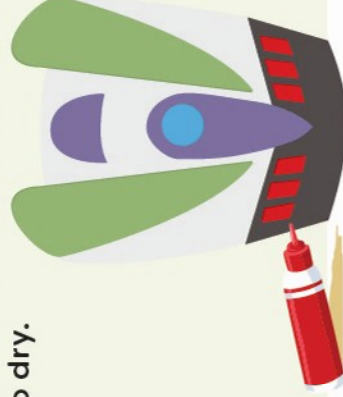

Cover the wings with construction paper. Cut out the white, red and green shapes as below, then stick them in place with craft glue. Repeat on the other side.

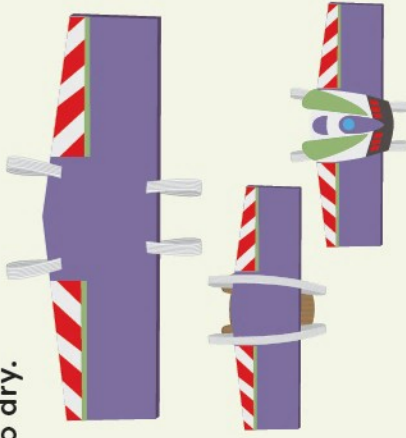
Draw the pack outline onto cardboard and cut it out. Then draw the shapes onto the construction paper, as shown below. Cut them out, arrange and stick them onto the cardboard with craft glue. Leave to dry.



CONTINUED

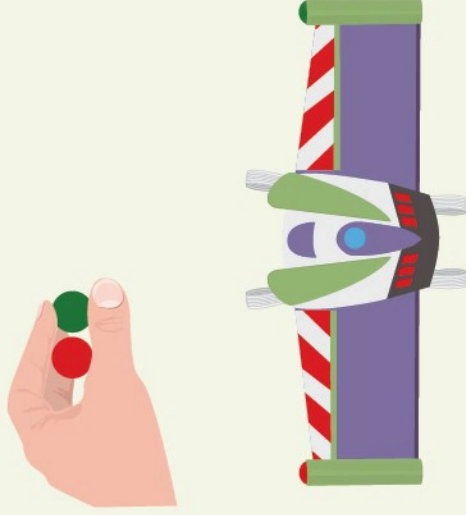

Have the Space Ranger lie on top of the wings, and mark their arm position. Tape elastic or ribbon into position for arm straps and glue the wing case over the top. Leave to dry.



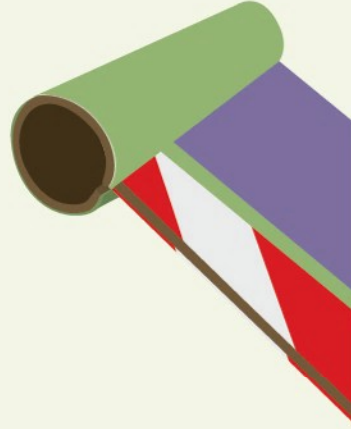

Slide the tubes onto the tips of the wings and glue into place. Paint two small balls—one red and one green. When they're dry, glue one at the end of each tube.

Cut two cardboard tubes so that they are the same length as the wing tips. Cover these with green paper. Make a slit along the length of each of them.
