

How to use your Preserving Jars

Cleaning

- Before using this product for the first time, wash it by hand and dry on a rack or tea towel.
- Always wash the product by hand after use. If residue is hard to remove, leave the product soaking for 1 hour with warm water and detergent.
- Do not use steel wool, harsh scorer or anything that may scratch the glass.
- If placing in a dishwasher, ensure the product is secure and not able to move during the wash cycle.
- Always leave the product to cool before handling or storing.

Sterilizing

- Always remove the lids completely before sterilizing
- If you want to sterilize the jar with boiling water or in the oven, preheat the jar first with warm tap water for ten minutes.
- When placing hot jars on your kitchen bench or workstation always place them on a tea towel to prevent sudden heat changes.



Sudden temperature changes may cause glass to break suddenly

Safety

- Avoid using metal utensils inside your jars. Scratches can cause weak points in the glass.
- Never place a hot jar onto a cold surface or a cold jar into boiling water. The sudden temperature change will cause the glass to break.
- When boiling avoid the jars knocking into each other with force. A gentle boil is best.
- Do not use if jar is scratched, chipped, or cracked.
