# Warning and Precaution

## Important Safety Instructions

- Read these instructions – All the safety and operating instructions should be read before this product is operated.
  - Keep these instructions – The safety and operating instructions should be retained for future reference.
  - Heed all warnings – All warnings on the appliance and in the operating instructions should be adhered to.

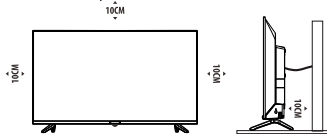

## Positioning the TV

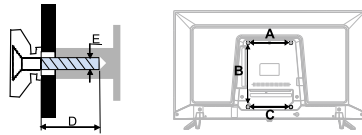

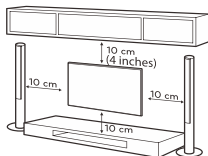
- Disconnect the power before moving or installing the TV. Otherwise electric shock may occur.

## Wall-hanging bracket

● An optional wall mount can be used with your television. Consult with your local dealer to purchase the recommended wall mount bracket. If you are attaching the TV to other building materials, please contact qualified personnel to install the wall mount. Detailed instructions will be included with the wall mount. - 2) For the TV sets with terminals towards the wall, in order to leave enough space to use the terminals, a rubber cushion is needed together with the screw to fix the wall mount. It is a small hollow pillar whose internal diameter is 8mm, external diameter is 18mm and height is  $\geq 30$ mm.

# Warning and Precaution

## Operating Environment

- . Do not install this equipment in a confined space such as a bookcase or similar unit.
- . Do not use the set near damp, and cold areas.
- . Keep away from direct sunlight, and protect the set from overheating.
- . Do not use the set near dust place.
- . Do not attach candle to accessible opening area, to avoid flammable foreign material from entering the TV.

## Precautions For Using Remote Control

- . Use the remote control by pointing it towards the remote sensor. The items between the remote control and the remote sensor will interfere the normal operation.
- . Do not make remote control vibrate violently. Also, do not splash liquid on the remote control, also do not put the remote control in high humidity place.
- . Do not place remote control under direct sunlight which will cause deformation of the unit by heat.
- . When the remote sensor is under direct sunlight or strong lighting, the remote control will not work. If so please change the lighting or TV's position, or operate the remote control closer to the remote sensor.

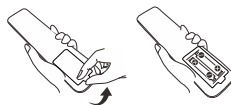
## Precautions For Using Battery

Improper using of the battery will cause leakage. So please do as the following methods and use carefully.

1. Please note the batteries' polarity, to avoid short circuit.
2. When the battery's voltage is insufficient which affect the use range, you should replace new battery. Remove the batteries from the remote control unit if you do not intend to use it for a long time.
3. Do not use different types of batteries (for example, Manganese and Alkaline batteries) together.
4. Do not put the battery into fire, and charge or decompose the battery.
5. Please dispose batteries abide by relevant environmental protection regulation.
6. **WARNING:** The batteries (battery pack or batteries installed) shall not be exposed to excessive heat such as sunshine, fire or the like.

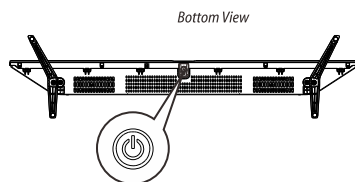
Place two AAA size batteries in the remote controls battery compartment, making sure to match the polarity markings inside the compartment.

# Remote Control Function

1. **MUTE**(🔇): Mute or restore the TV sound.
2. **POWER**(⏻): Turn the TV on or standby.
3. **Number buttons (0~9)**: Choose the channel directly, or input a number.
4. **RETURN**: Switch to the previously-viewed channel.
5. **LIST**: Access the channel list.
6. **SOURCE**: Select the input source.
7. **MENU**: Access or exit the main menu settings, or return to the upper-level menu.
8. **OK**: Confirm, enter or execute the selected item, or access the channel list.
9. **UP/DOWN/LEFT/RIGHT (▲/▼/◀/▶)**:  
Navigate the menu to select what you need.
10. **AUDIO**: Setup the audio language in DTV mode, or select the sound track in ATV mode.
11. **EXIT**: Exit the current operation.
12. **INFO**: Check the detailed information of current program.
13. **Volume Up/Down(VOL+/VOL-)**:  
Adjust the sound volume.
14. **Program Up/Down(PR^/PRv)**:  
Change Channels.
15. **SUBTITLE**: Setup the subtitle languages.
16. **GUIDE**: Access the electronic program guide in DTV mode.
17. **USB Play Control Buttons**
  - Fast Backward (◀◀)**: Fast backward the playback.
  - Fast Forward (▶▶)**: Fast forward the playback.
  - Play & Pause (▶||)**: Start or pause the playback.
18. **REVEAL/HOLD/INDEX**: No functions.
19. **Color Buttons (RED/GREEN/YELLOW/BLUE)**:  
Execute the prompt function in specific mode.

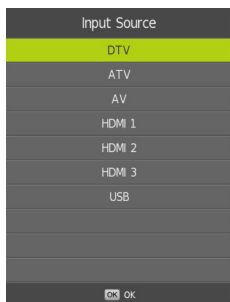
# Basic Operations

## Turn on or turn off the TV

- Step 1.** Connect the AC power cord to power outlet, then the TV goes to standby mode, press **POWER**  button on the remote control to turn on the TV, and you will be ready to use its features.
- Step 2.** When the TV is turned on, press **POWER**  button to turn off the TV, and it will go to standby mode.
- Step 3.** If you want to power off the TV completely, please pull out the power plug from the power outlet.

## Input Source

- Step 1.** Press **SOURCE** button to enter the list of input sources.
- Step 2.** Press **▲/▼** button to select the desired source.
- Step 3.** Press **OK** button to enter the selected source.

## Initial Setup

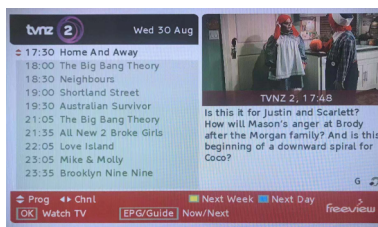
When you turn on the TV for the first time, there will show a setup wizard on the screen to guide you to finish the initial setup.

- Step 1:** Select the OSD language.
- Step 2:** Select your country.
- Step 3:** Search for channels automatically.

*Note: If you want to restart the initial setup after first time, please select <MENU → OPTION → First Time Installation>.*

## Electronic Program Guide (New Zealand)

While watching a DTV program, please press **GUIDE** button to enter Electronic Program Guide, where you can check program information of 8 days including the current day for all available channels.



*Note: The picture is only for reference.*

- **YELLOW:** Check the program list of next week or previous day.
- **BLUE:** Check the program list of next day or today.
- **GUIDE:** Check the current and next programs of all channels.
- **▲/▼/◀/▶:** Move to select the desired channel or program.

## Electronic Program Guide (Other Countries)

While watching a DTV program, please press **GUIDE** button to enter Electronic Program Guide, where you can check program information of 8 days including the current day for all available channels.

- **GREEN:** Check the detailed program information.
- **YELLOW:** Check the list of viewing appointments.
- **BLUE:** Setup a viewing appointment to remind you of watching the selected program.
- **▲/▼/◀/▶:** Move to select the desired channel or program.

# Main Menu

## Menu Operation

- Step 1.** Press **MENU** button to enter the main menu settings.
- Step 2.** Press **◀/▶** button to select a submenu: **CHANNEL, PICTURE, SOUND, TIME, OPTION** or **LOCK**.
- Step 3.** Press **OK/▼** button to enter the selected submenu.
- Step 4.** Press **▲/▼** button to select an item.
- Step 5.** Press **OK** button to enter the selected item.
- Step 6.** Press **▲/▼** or **◀/▶** button to adjust the item.
- Step 7.** Press **MENU** button to return to the upper-level menu or exit main menu setting.

## CHANNEL (Only for TV mode)

**Auto Tuning:** Search for channels automatically.

**DVB-T Manual Tuning:** Search for DTV channels manually.

**ATV Manual Tuning:** Search for ATV channels manually.

**Program Edit:** Edit the selected program.

- Press **RED** button to delete the program.
- Press **GREEN** button to rename the program in ATV mode.
- Press **YELLOW** button to move the program in ATV mode.
- Press **BLUE** button to skip the program.

**Signal Information:** (Only for DTV mode) Check the detailed information of the current signal.

**LCN:** Turn on the LCN switch to get logical channel number automatically from the program.

**Software Update (USB):** Update the TV software by inserting a USB device with the newest version of software.

*Note: For service use only. If the wrong software is loaded onto the television, it could compromise the functions of television and void the warranty.*

## PICTURE

**Picture Mode:** Select the appropriate picture mode for different purposes. Only when the picture mode is set to be "User", you can adjust "**Contrast**", "**Brightness**", "**Saturation**", "**Tint**" and "**Sharpness**".

**Contrast:** Adjust the differences between light and dark areas of the picture.

**Brightness:** Adjust the lightness of the picture.

**Saturation:** Adjust the color richness of the picture.

**Tint:** (Only for NTSC system) Adjust the color tint of the picture.

**Sharpness:** Adjust the edge of the picture.

**Color Temperature:** Select the overall color temperature of the picture.

**Aspect Ratio:** Select the display mode of the picture.

**Noise Reduction:** Reduce the noise generated with the picture signal.

# Main Menu

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## SOUND

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**Sound Mode:** Select the desired sound mode. Only when the picture mode is set to be "User", you can adjust the value of "120Hz", "500Hz", "1.5KHz", "5KHz" and "10KHz".

**Balance:** Control the sound balance between the right and left speakers.

**Auto Volume:** Turn on to adjust the sound volume automatically depending on the input source.

**Surround Sound:** Setup surround sound system to enjoy an optimum sound effect.

**SPDIF Mode:** Select the type of digital audio output.

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## TIME

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**Clock:** Show or setup the TV date and time.

**Off Time:** Setup the desired time when you want to turn off the TV.

**On Time:** Setup the desired time when you want to turn on the TV.

**Sleep Timer:** Setup the sleep timer in minute to turn off the TV automatically.

**Auto Standby:** Setup the standby timer in hour to turn off the TV automatically when there is no operation during the selected time duration.

**Time Zone:** Select the time zone.

**OSD Timer:** Setup the time duration to keep OSD displayed on the screen without disappearing.

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## OPTION

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**OSD Language:** Select the desired OSD language.

**Audio Languages:** (Only for DTV mode) Select the primary and secondary audio languages.

**Subtitle Language:** (Only for DTV mode) Select the primary and secondary subtitle languages.

**Hearing Impaired:** Turn on to help the hearing-impaired viewers understand and enjoy the programs.

**Reset:** Restore user settings to the factory default values.

**HDMI CEC:** Control the connected HDMI devices.

- HDMI CEC: Turn on or turn off the HDMI link system.
- HDMI ARC: Turn on or turn off the HDMI ARC function.
- Auto Standby: Turn off the connected HDMI device automatically when you turn off the TV.
- Auto TV on: Turn on the TV automatically when you turn on the connected HDMI device.
- Device Control: Turn on to allow TV remote to control the connected HDMI device simultaneously.
- Device List: Show the list of connected HDMI devices.

**First Time Installation:** Restart the initial setup.

*Note: HDMI ARC is only available on HDMI 1 port.*

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## LOCK

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Before entering the lock system, you will be asked to input the password firstly. And the initial password is "0000".

**Lock System:** Turn on or turn off the lock system.

**Set Password:** Change the password of lock system as you like. If you forget your password, please try to use the master password "9988".

**Block Program:** Restrict unauthorized access to the specific program based on the program content.

**Parental Guidance:** Restrict unauthorized access to the specific program based on the age rating.

**Key Lock:** Turn on to disable the function of TV control button.

# Media Player

## Media Operation

You can view photo, music, movie and text files from your USB storage devices on the TV.



*Note: The pictures are only for references.*

- Step 1.** Connect your USB storage device to USB terminal of the TV.
- Step 2.** Press **SOURCE** button and select "USB" to enter the USB interface.
- Step 3.** Press ◀/▶ to select the USB file type: **PHOTO**, **MUSIC**, **MOVIE** or **TEXT**.
- Step 4.** Press **OK** button to enter it.
- Step 5.** Press ▲/▼/◀/▶ and **OK** buttons to select the USB file you need.
- Step 6.** Press ▶|| button to start playing.
- Step 7.** Press **RETURN** button to exit playing.

*Note: Please select the USB file of which the type is same as one selected in USB interface. For example, if you select "MOVIE" type in USB interface, you need to select a movie or video in your USB disk to play. Otherwise, you will not find or play it correctly.*

## Gentle Reminder

1. Some USB storage devices may not be compatible to operate smoothly with this TV.
2. Back up all of the data in the USB storage device in case data was lost due to an unexpected accident.  
We do not assume any liability for the losses by misuse or malfunction. Data backup is consumer's responsibility.
3. For large file sizes, the loading speed may be slightly longer.
4. The recognition speed of a USB storage device may depend on each device.
5. When connecting or disconnecting the USB storage device, ensure that the TV is not in USB mode otherwise the USB storage device or the files stored in it may be damaged.
6. Please use only a USB storage device which is formatted in FAT32 (Max. 2TB) or NTFS (Max. 256TB) file system provided with the Windows operating system. In case of a storage device formatted as a different utility programme which is not supported by Windows, it may not be recognized.
7. When using a USB Hard Disk Drive which requires electric power source, ensure its rated current does not exceed the marked one at the USB terminal of the TV. Otherwise, the TV system may be changed into standby mode, you should pull away the USB hard Disk and restart the TV system.
8. FHD big picture needs longer time to process, which is not caused by the TV. Please be patient to wait.
9. This TV may not support some multimedia files changed and upgraded as the change of encoding format or other technical advances.

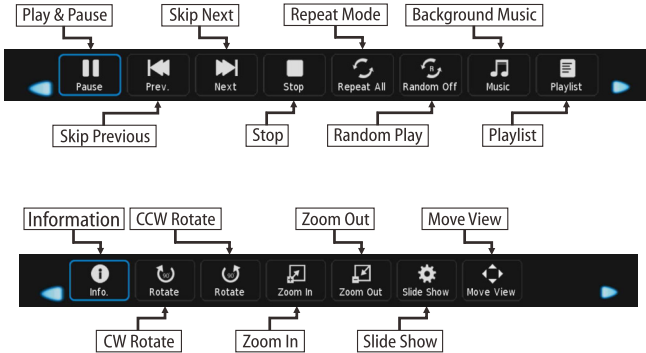

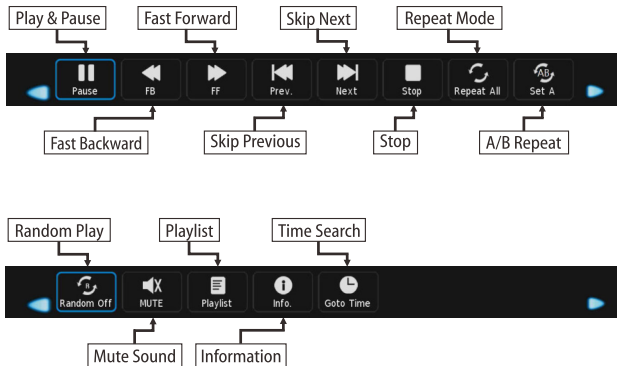
### PHOTO

2. Press **◀/▶** button to select an operation, and press **OK** button to enter or execute the operation.



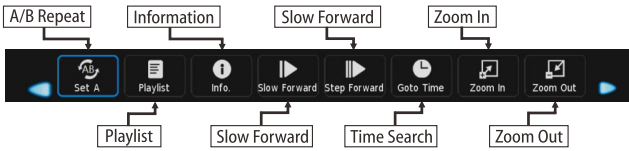
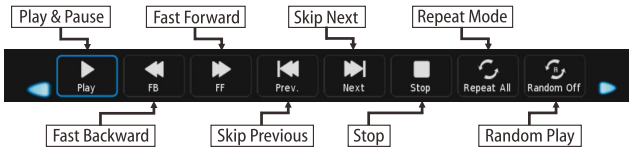

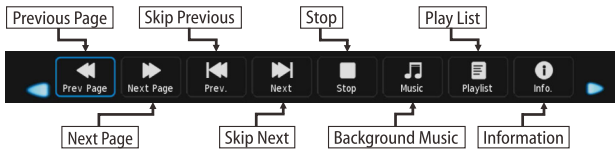
### MOVIE

# Troubleshooting

Before calling a service technician, please check the following table for a possible cause of the symptom and some solutions.

## ■ General Problem / Solution

### Remote control does not work

- . Check if there is an obstacle between remote control and TV receiver.
- . Change the batteries.
- . Batteries are not installed correctly.
- . Main power is not connected.

### Poor Signal

This is usually caused by interference from cell phones, walkie-talkie, automotive ignition system; neon, electric drill or other electronic equipment or radio interference sources.

## ■ Picture & Sound / Solution

### No picture, no sound

- . Check the signal source.
- . Plug another electrical device into the outlet to make sure it is working or turned on.
- . Power Plug is bad contact with the outlet.
- . Check the signal.

### No sound, picture OK

- . If no sound, increase or do not mute the sound volume.
- . Open the sound menu and adjust 'Balance'.
- . Check if a headphone has been inserted in, if so, pull out the headphone.

### Abnormal picture

- . For no color or bad picture quality, you may:
  1. Adjust the color option in menu settings.
  2. Keep the TV at a sufficient distance from other electronic products.
  3. Try another channel, maybe broadcasting signal problem.
- . Bad TV signal (Display mosaic or snowflakes)
  1. Check the signal cable and adjust the antenna.
  2. Fine tune the channel.
  3. Try another channel.

## ■ Multimedia Player / Solution

### "This file is invalid" appears or audio is normal but video is abnormal

- . The media file maybe damaged, check if the file can be played on the PC.
- . Check if video and audio codec is supported.

### "Unsupported file" appears or video is normal but audio is abnormal

- . The media file maybe damaged, check if the file can be played on the PC.
- . Check if video and audio codec is supported.

## ■ Network / Solution (May not be available)

### Network failure

- . Check if the router works well.
- . Make sure the TV has connected to the router successfully.

## ■ Browser / Solution (May not be available)

### Web page can not be displayed completely

- . Flash is not supported.

### Browser is forced to be shut down

- . Web page include too many large pictures, thus lead to insufficient memory and close the browser.
