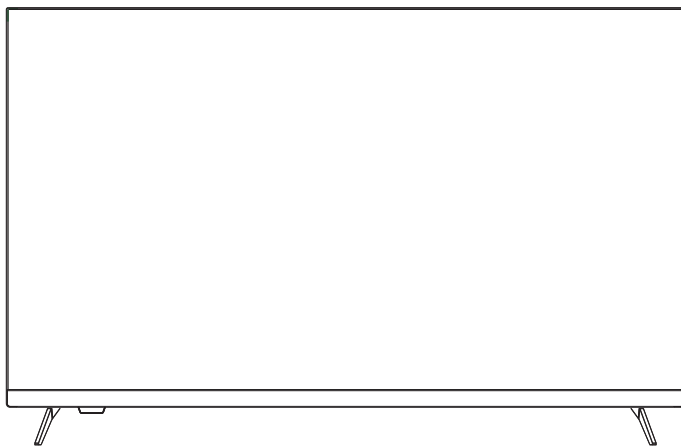

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

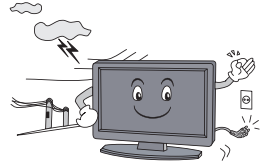


9. Do not defeat the safety purpose of the polarized or grounding type plug. A polarized plug has two blades with one wider than other. Fixing the stand

Your TV is packaged with the stand and the cabinet separated. Before using the TV, install the stand as described below, or if you want to mount it to wall, see page 6 for mounting advice; the wall mount itself is not supplied.

IMPORTANT!

- Make sure the TV set is unplugged from the power supply before installing or removing the stand.
- The TV panel may be awkward to install on your own. We recommend you ask someone to help with installation and/or removal of the stand.

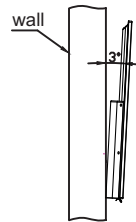
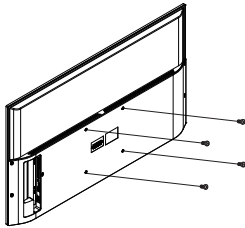
Wall mount installation

1. Fix the wall mount screws (top holes: M4x12mm/2pcs, bottom holes: M4x8mm/2pcs) into the rear side of the LED TV, using the torque of 8kgf.cm.

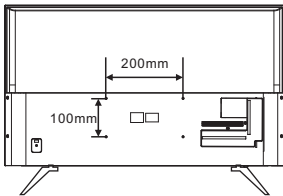

2. Use the wall mount (not included) to mount the TV to the wall.

Warning: the angle between the TV and wall must not be bigger than 3°.



There are four mounting holes on the back of your TV for mounting a wall mount bracket (not included). Use only mounting screws (not included) that match the length and diameter specified in the instructions.



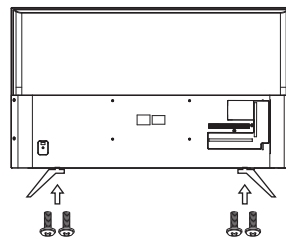
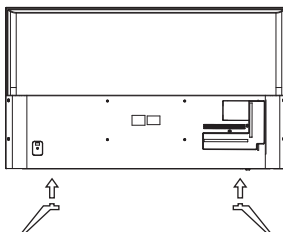

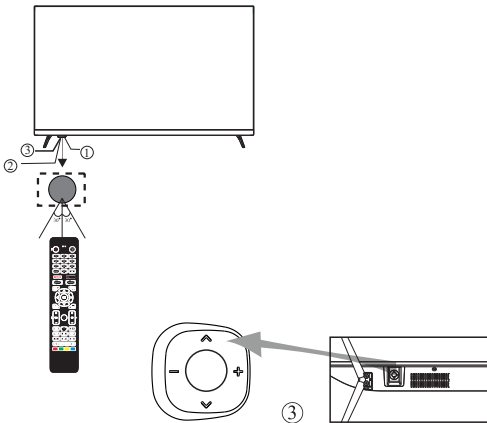
Attaching the stand

1. Place the TV with the display side down on a flat surface. Use a cloth to protect the display. Place the panel side of TV on the platform and insert the two stands into TV, making the screws holes of stands correspond to the right holes of TV.

2. Fix screws on the bottom of back cover, assembly finished.

Select the next channel or move up.

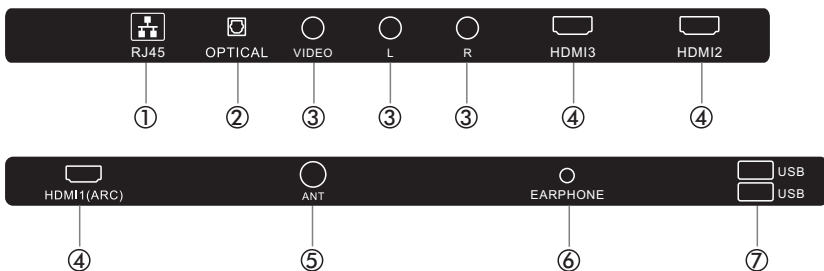
Select the previous channel or move down.

Getting Started

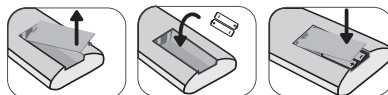
Using the remote control

When using the remote control, aim it at remote sensor on the television. If there is an object between the remote control and the remote sensor on the unit, the unit may not operate.

- ◆ Point the remote control at the REMOTE SENSOR located on the television.
- ◆ When using this television in a very brightly lit area, the infrared REMOTE CONTROL SENSOR may not work properly.
- ◆ The recommended effective distance for using the remote control is about 7 metres.

Installing Batteries in the Remote Control

1. Open the cover at the back of the remote control.
2. Install two AAA size batteries. Make sure to match the "+" and "-" ends of the batteries with the diagram inside the compartment.
3. Replace the cover.



Batteries replacement

You will need to install the batteries into the remote control to make it operate following the instruction below.

When the batteries become weak, the operating distance of the remote control will be greatly reduced and you will need to replace the batteries.

Notes on Using Batteries:

The use of the wrong type of batteries may cause chemical leakage and/or explosion. Please note the following:

- ◆ Always ensure that the batteries are inserted with the + and - terminals in the correct direction as shown in the battery compartment.
- ◆ Different types of batteries have different characteristic. Do not mix different types.
- ◆ Do not mix old and new batteries. Mixing old and new batteries will shorten battery life and/or cause chemical leakage.
- ◆ Replace batteries as soon as they do not work.
- ◆ Chemicals which leak from batteries may cause skin irritation. If any chemical matter seeps out of the batteries, wipe it up immediately with a dry cloth and replace with new battery immediately.
- ◆ The batteries may have a shorter life expectancy due to storage conditions. Remove the batteries whenever you anticipate that the remote control will not be used for an extended period.
- ◆ The batteries (battery pack or batteries installed) shall not be exposed to excessive heat such as sunshine, fire or the like.

CAUTION

- ◆ It may result in an explosion if batteries are replaced incorrectly.
- ◆ Only replace batteries with the same or equivalent type.

Cable Installation

Please read the relevant content in "Notice for Maintenance and Safety" carefully before the installation and use.

1. Remove the TV from the retail carton and place on a secure flat surface.

NOTE

- ◆ When you plug or unplug the TV, you must make sure that the AC power has been already shut down; when unplugging the power cable or signal cable, please hold the plug(the insulated part), do not draw the body of the cable.
2. The RF output terminal can be connected with the RF input port of the TV.
 3. The output AV terminal of DVD can be connected with the AV input port of the TV through AV cable.
 4. Connect one end of the HDMI cable with HDMI output port, connect the other end of the HDMI cable with the HDMI port on the TV. **It supports HDCP 2.2 on all HDMI input.**

NOTE

- ◆ While connecting the HDMI, please insert carefully, do not insert overexertedly, for fear the pin might be broken. HDMI cable is not supplied with television.
5. Check and make sure that all AV cables are connected with the corresponding ports correctly.
 6. Connect the AV power cable with 100-240VAC power supply.

NOTE

- ◆ The range of power input for the TV is 100-240V AC 50/60 Hz, do not connect the TV power input port with the AV power out of the above range.
- ◆ Please hold the insulated part of the plug when you are unplugging the power cable, do not touch any metal part of the power cable directly.

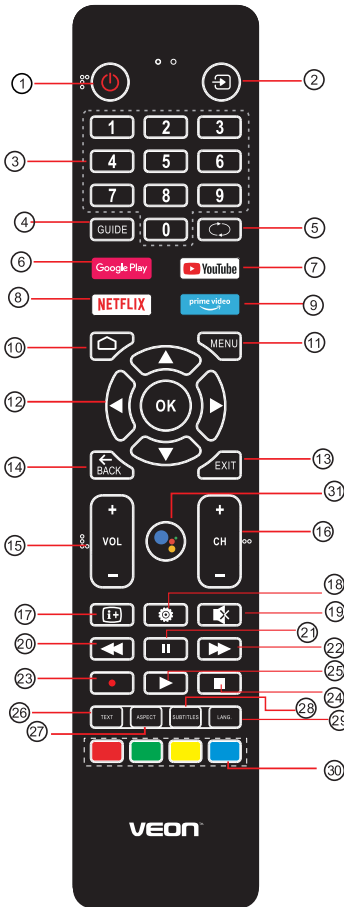

Press the  /  /  /  button, then press the OK button.
2. Select the appropriate country.
Press the  /  /  /  button to select the country, then press the OK button to follow OSD Menu and start channel tuning

This Remote Control is used across a range of TV models with differing capabilities. Some functions listed above may not be applicable to your TV model.

Turning on and off TV

- Turn on the TV

Connect the Power cable. At this time the TV will enter **standby** mode.
press the  button on remote control to turn on TV from standby mode.

- Turn off the TV

press the  button on remote control to enter standby mode.
Do not leave your set in standby mode for long periods of time. It is best to unplug the set from the mains and aerial.

Program Selection

- Using the CH+/CH- on the panel of TV or on the remote control.

Press CH+ to increase channel number.

Press CH- to decrease channel number.

- Using 0-9 digital buttons.

You can select the channel number by pressing 0 to 9.(In TV, DTV mode)

Volume adjustment


- Press the VOL+/- button to adjust the volume.

- If you want to switch the sound OFF, press the MUTE.

- You can release mute by pressing the MUTE or increase/ decrease the volume.

Changing the Input Source

You can select the input source by pressing the  button on the remote control.

Press the  button to cycle through the input source, and press the OK button to confirm your choice.

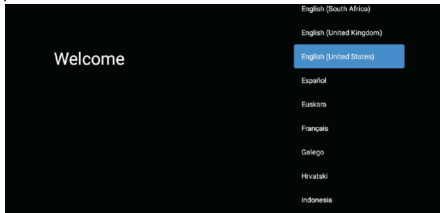
INITIAL SETUP

For the first initial setup, on screen setup wizard will guide you through setting up your TV. Please follow the on-screen instructions to setup your TV correctly.

Remote Control Pairing

Be sure to follow the below prompts to pair your Bluetooth remote control. After the pairing is successful, you can now operate the TV.

Use the ▲/▼ buttons to select system language, then press **OK/SELECT** to confirm.



Press **LEFT + MENU** (down) buttons for 3 seconds until red light starts to blink. Select and click OK when the remote control appears on the screen. Once connected, you can use the Bluetooth remote control to operate the TV.



If you just want to use your TV normally, please select **"SKIP"**

To connect your Android™ smartphone to your TV, Select **"Continue"**.

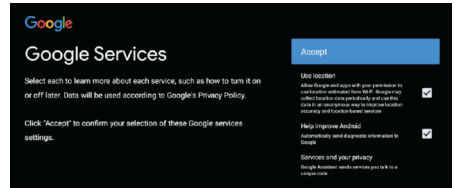

5. **SETTINGS:** Select this if you want to access TV settings.
6. **TIME:** Displaying current time.
7. Each row past this point will display recommended content from the apps you already have installed.

IMPORTANT - You must have a **USB Drive** inserted into the USB Port of the TV in order to use any of these **"RECORD"** functions. (Must be FAT32 format)

Start record- press the remote Record button (#23 on page 10)



Stop record-press the remote Stop button (#24 on page 10)

Record List - Select **"Record List"** to view all previous recordings.

Device Info - Select **"Device Info"** to view information about your storage device.

Schedule List - Select **"Schedule List"** to see future programs you have scheduled to record.

Troubleshooting

No sound and picture	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Check whether the main plug has been connected to a wall outlet. - Check whether you have pressed the POWER button on the TV set. - Check the picture contrast and brightness setting.
Normal picture but no sound	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Check the volume. - Sound muted? Press the MUTE button. - Try another channel, the problem may be with the broadcast. - Are the audio cables installed properly?
The remote control does not work	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Check to see if there any object between the product and remote control causing obstruction. - Are batteries installed with correct polarity(+ to +, - to -)? - Correct remote operating mode set: TV, VCR etc.? - Install new batteries.
Power is suddenly turned off	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Is the sleep timer set? - Check the power control settings. Power interrupted. -No broadcast on station tuned with auto activated.
Picture appears slowly after switching on	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - This is normal, the image is muted during the product startup process. Please contact your service center, if the picture has not appeared after five minutes.
No or poor color or poor picture	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Adjust the color in menu option. - Keep a sufficient distance between the product and the VCR. - Try another channel, the problem may be with the broadcast. - Are the VIDEO cables installed properly? - Activate the any function to restore the brightness of the picture.
Horizontal/vertical bars or picture shaking	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Check for local interference such as an electrical appliance or power tool.
Poor reception on some channels	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Station or cable product experiencing problems. Tune to another station. - Station signal is weak, reorient antenna to receive weaker station. - Check for sources of possible interference.

Maintenance

Early malfunction can be prevented. Careful and regular cleaning can extend the amount of time you will have your new TV. Be sure to turn the power off and unplug the power cord before you begin any cleaning.

Cleaning the screen

1. Here's a great way to keep the dust off your screen for a while. Wet a soft cloth in a mixture of lukewarm water and a little fabric softener or dish washing detergent. Wring the cloth until it's almost dry, and then used it to wipe the screen.
2. Make sure the excess water is off the screen, and then let it air-dry before you turn on your TV.

Cleaning the cabinet

To remove dirt or dust, wipe the cabinet with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth. Please be sure not to use a wet cloth.

If you expect to leave your TV dormant for a long time (such as a vacation), it's a good idea to unplug the power cord and antenna to protect against possible damage from lightning or power surges.
